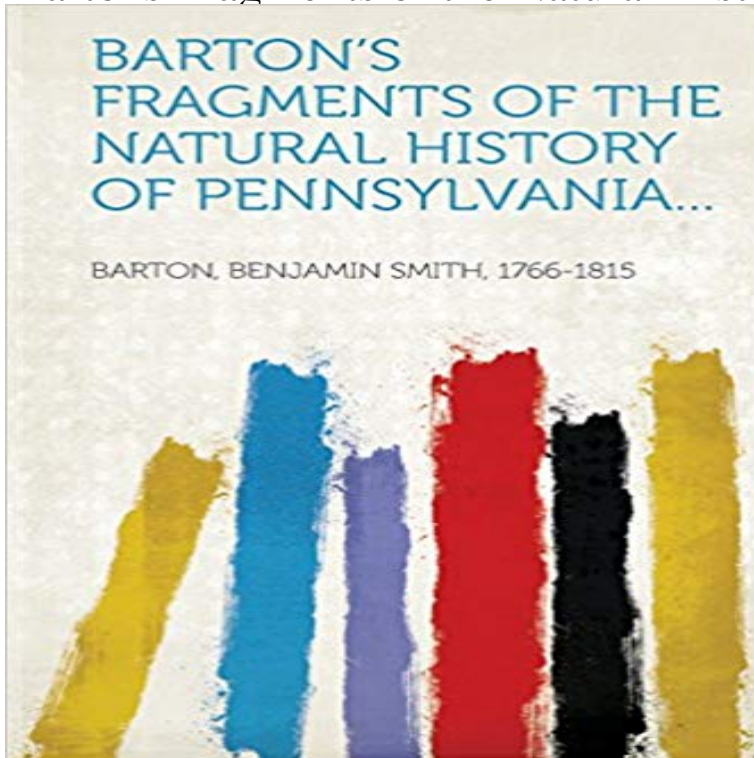


## Bartons Fragments of the Natural History of Pennsylvania...
