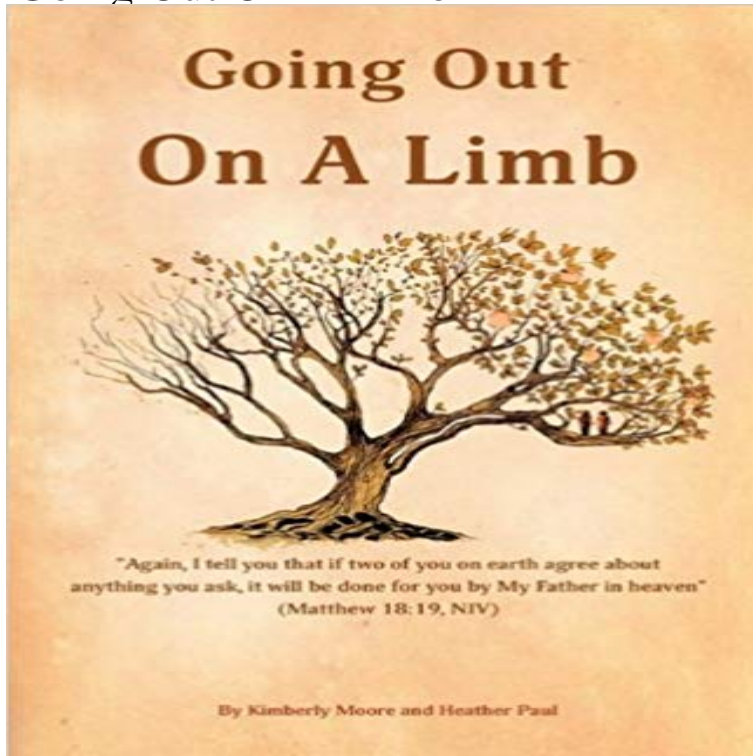


Going Out On A Limb
