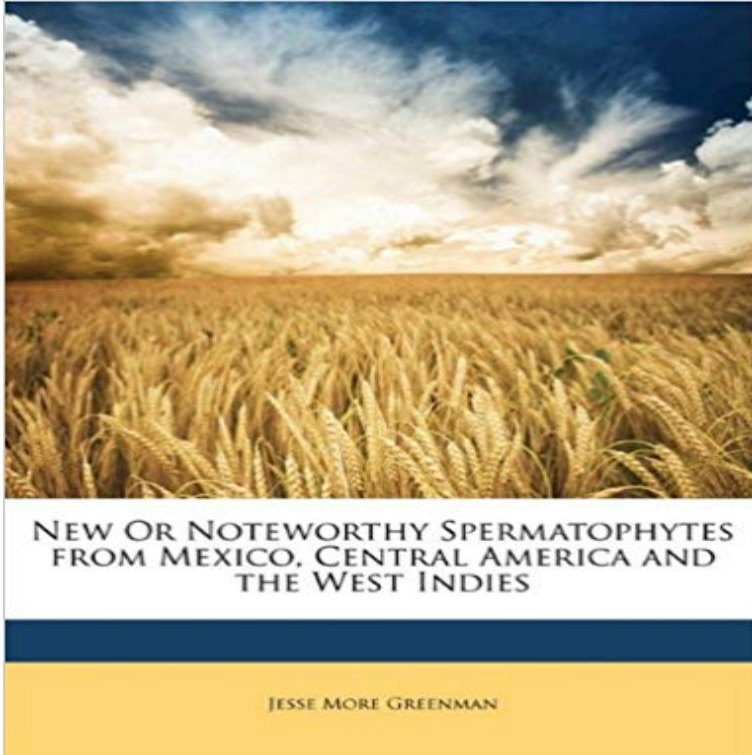


New Or Noteworthy Spermatophytes from Mexico, Central America and the West Indies
