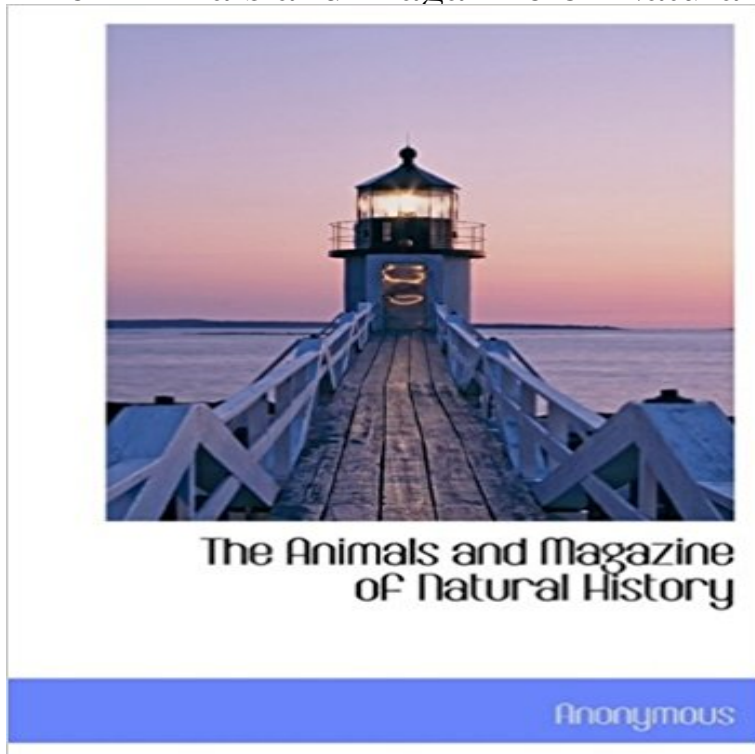


The Animals and Magazine of Natural History
