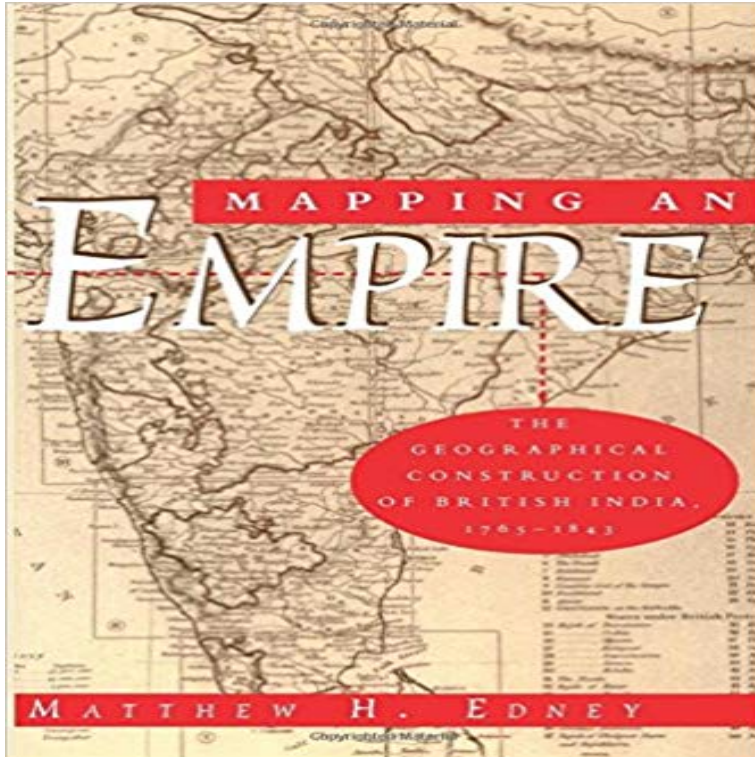


# Mapping an Empire: The Geographical Construction of British India, 1765-1843
