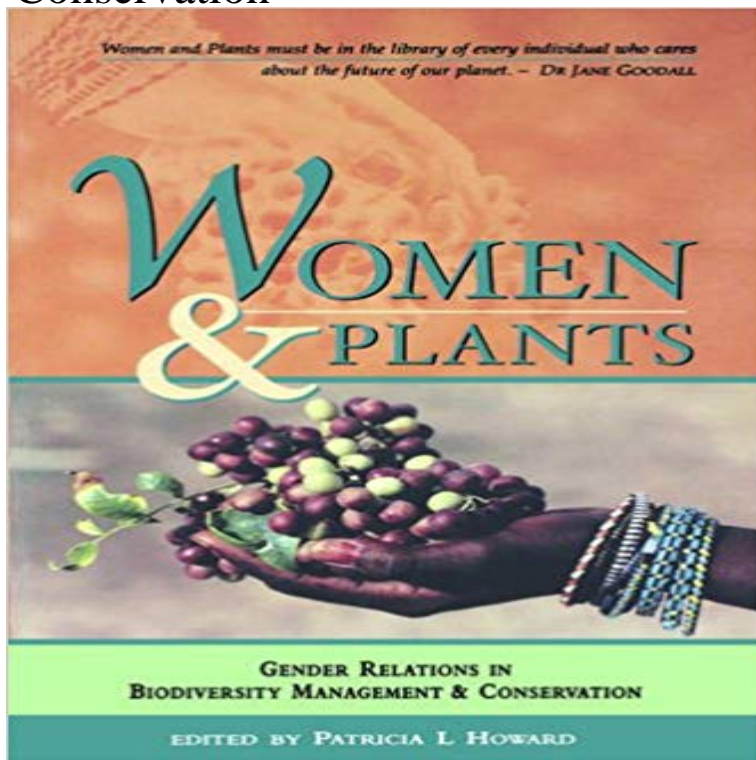


# Women and Plants: Gender Relations in Biodiversity Management and Conservation
