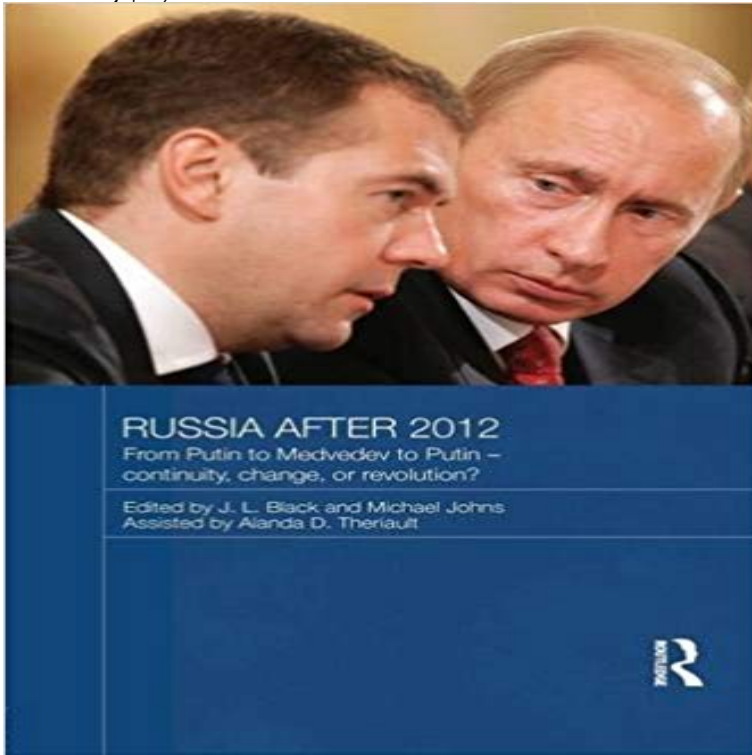


## Russia after 2012: From Putin to Medvedev to Putin - Continuity, Change, or Revolution?
